



2024 BC SUMMER GAMES SELECTION INFORMATION

OVERVIEW

This document will serve as the selection document for all BC Summer Games Zone Teams for the 2024 BC Summer Games July 18-21, 2024, in Maple Ridge, BC. All selections will be made in accordance with these criteria. Athletes, coaches, and parents are asked to please familiarize themselves with this document. ZONE TEAM SELECTION ELIGIBILITY

For athletes to be eligible for BC Summer Games Zone Teams, they must:

- a. Complete the **BC SUMMER GAMES ATHLETE DECLARATION** before June 3, 2024 @ 11:59pm
- b. Only be attending the 2024 BC Summer Games in the sport of Athletics.
- c. For Zones using Selection Trials, athletes must attend the trial competition. If you cannot attend the trials selection meet, athletes may still be selected to a team through the Wild Card selection using results achieved during the Qualification Period (see above). Results must either be posted on the Athletics Canada Rankings or be submitted through the BC Summer Games Athlete Declaration form.
- d. Register as either a 2024 BC Athletics Competitive U16 Athlete Member or a 2024 BC Athletics BC Summer Games membership upon confirmation of selection to a Zone Team

SELECTION TYPES BY ZONE

2024 BC Summer Games Zones will be selected using the following Selection Types:

SELECTION OBJECTIVES

BC Summer Games Selection Objectives are as follows:

- To provide a clear and accessible path for athlete selection to BC Zone Teams
- To fill as many spots on BC Zone Teams as possible
- To provide each zone with the best athletes living within their zone
- To provide as many athletes as possible with a positive experience through Track & Field

SELECTION PROCESS

As noted above, BC Games Zones may select their teams based on two (2) selection types: a Trials Based Selection and a Performance Based Selection. Athletes will be selected to teams based on the following processes:

1. TRIALS BASED SELECTION

- a. Athletes must compete at the published BC Summer Games Zone Trials (see Table 2)
- b. Athletes will be selected based on the performance at the Zone Trials Meet
- c. Athletes who cannot participate in the Zone Trials can still be selected to a team through the Wild Card spots based on performances during the Qualification Period (see Table 1)

2. PERFORMANCE BASED SELECTION

- a. Athletes must record a result during the qualification period (see Table 1)
- b. Athletes will be selected based on their performances during the selection period until team spots are full.

3. WILD CARD SELECTION

- a. Wild Card spots will be used to select remaining athletes to All Zones regardless of whether or not Selection Based Trials or Performance Based Trials are used.
- b. Wild Card spots for all zones will be selected based on athlete performances during the Qualification Period (March 1 – June 3).

SUBMITTING RESULTS

Athletes may submit results based by:

- a. **2024 BC Athletics Competitive Members** should ensure that results are added to the [Athletics Canada Rankings page](#) prior to June 3, 2024. BC Athletics sanctioned meets will have their results updated to the AC Rankings, however parents, athletes and coaches are asked to double check. Results may take 1-2 days to show up on the rankings.
- b. **Non 2024 BC Athletics Competitive Members** should submit their results from either the [BC Athletics Sanctioned Event](#) or the BC School Sports Zone Championships via the [Athlete Declaration Form](#).

- c. If an athlete is selected and is NOT a BC Athletics Competitive Member, they must purchase a BC Athletics Summer Games membership to be eligible.
