### **General Information**

Each Zone Team will have one (1) Zone Rep. The role of the Zone Rep includes:

- Organizing Zone Trials
   – ensuring all eligible athletes in their zone have the opportunity to qualify for the BC Summer Games.
- Team Selection working with Provincial Advisor (PA) Workbook and instructions to be provided by PA.
- Promote qualification events and the zone team selection in a good way to gain exposure for our Sport for all club, unattached and school athletes.
- Media Contact lists are available on the BC Games resource site including sample press releases and promotional ideas.
- Manage registration of athletes, coaches, and adult supervisors working with Provincial Advisor (PA) – registration package will be provided in spring by BC Games along with info sessions. Please send your excel lists to PA for upload to BC Games system, do NOT directly upload yourselves.
- Collect registration fee for all athletes in their zone (fees can be found in our Technical Package \$175 BC Games Fee and \$60 BC Athletic Fee for a total of \$235.) This fee will include a uniform, registration into games as well as an opening ceremonies item unique to track and field to be used/worn at the opening ceremonies – items tba.



## Eligibility

- The Zone Rep usually attend the games in the capacity of Adult Supervisor or Zone Team Coach. Though this is highly recommended, attendance of the Games by a Zone Rep is <u>not mandatory</u>.
- Attendance of the Games includes travelling to and from the Games with the team/zone, residing with the team/zone in BC Games accommodation, and acting in a supervisory capacity throughout the Games.
- Any participant who stays in Games accommodation must remain in accommodation for the duration of the Games.
- Anyone who removes themselves from Games accommodation prior to the completion of the Games (prior to Sunday) will be disqualified from competition and may be subject to additional disciplinary action.

## Requirements

To be selected as a Zone Team Rep for the BC Summer Games, coaches must meet the following requirements:

 a. All Zone Reps must be BC Athletics Associate Members. This includes obtaining a Criminal Records Check (CRC) and completing the NCCP Safe Sport Training Course. (Click here for more info).
