General Information

Each zone must have one (1) head coach and one (1) assistant coach and up to two (2) additional adults who will be registered as assistant coaches or adult supervisors. Click here to view further information and general rules. As a reminder:

- There must be at least one (1) adult of each gender; and
- The minimum age for adults attending the BC Summer Games is 19 years of age.

Eligibility

The role of head coaches and assistant coaches at the BC Games includes travelling to and from the Games with the team/zone, residing with the team/zone in BC Games accommodation, and acting in a supervisory capacity throughout the Games.

Any participant who stays in Games accommodation must remain in accommodation for the duration of the Games.

Anyone who removes themselves from Games accommodation prior to the completion of the Games (prior to Sunday) will be disqualified from competition and may be subject to additional disciplinary action, this includes coaches.



Requirements

To be selected as a Zone Team Coach for the BC Summer Games, coaches must meet the following requirements:

- All coaches must be BC Athletics Coach Members (Click here for more info);
- b. Head Coaches must be NCCP Certified Club Coach or equivalent (Click here for more info);
- c. Assistant Coaches must be a minimum NCCP Trained Sport Coach in Athletics;
- d. Adult supervisors must be a minimum of BC Athletics Associate Member;
- e. All coaches and adult supervisors must have completed the CAC Making Ethical Decisions module and Safe Sport Certification (Click here for more info)
