**Who:** <u>James Hustvedt</u> (wheelchair racing) is currently the provincial wheelchair athletics coach. James has been coaching for over 10 years with BCWSA and was a Team BC Staff Coach at 3 Canada Summer Games.

<u>Rick Reelie</u> (wheelchair racing) is currently a national team wheelchair athletics coach from Saskatchewan. Rick is a Paralympian who has been involved with wheelchair racing for over 30 years.

<u>Lisa Myers</u> (seated throws) is currently the provincial seated throws athletics coach. Lisa has been coaching seated throws for 4 years and was on the Team BC Staff at the 2013 Canada Summer Games.

<u>Ken Hall</u> (seated throws) is from Ontario and has been a High Performance Coach since 2003 including the National Team Assistant Coach in 2012 for the London Paralympics.

<u>Marni Abbott-Peter</u> (inclusive play) is currently the Director for the BCWBS Let's Play program. She is a Paralympian who has been coaching wheelchair basketball for over 20 years.

**What:** A hands-on introduction to inclusive play and wheelchair athletics (wheelchair racing and seated throws).
