

BC Athletics Road Running Championships Award Eligibility

BC Athletics is pleased to announce the awards eligibility and prizing structure for all 2024 BC Athletics Road Running Championships (5KM, 8KM, 10KM, Half Marathon, Marathon).

Award Categories:

U20 Awards (Athletics aged 18-19, as of December 31, 2024)

• Eligible for Championship medals for top 3 male and top 3 female U20 athletes.

Senior Awards (Athletes aged 20-34, as of December 31, 2024)

- Eligible for Championship medals for top 3 male and top 3 female Senior athletes.
- U20 athletes are eligible to compete up one age group, and must register in the category they wish to race in.
- Master's aged athletes who hold a Senior/Master membership are eligible to register in the Senior category.
- The top 3 male and top 3 female Senior athletes across the line are eligible for the Senior cash prize (\$200, \$150, \$100).

Master's Awards (Athletes aged 35+, based on age on the day of event)

- Eligible for Championships medals for athletes aged 35+, top 3 male and top 3 female across the line (not age graded).
- Eligible for Championship ribbons for top 3 male and top 3 female in 5-year age groups (e.g. 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 54-59 etc. up to 100+).
- The top 3 male and top 3 female Master's across the line are eligible for the Masters cash prize (not age graded) (\$200.00, \$150.00, \$100.00).

Eligibility Requirements:

- Athletes are only eligible to win prize money from the category in which they are registered.
- Athletes must register for the Championship on the Championship registration page (in addition to race registration) to be eligible for awards.
- Athletes must hold a BC Athletics competitive or limited competitive membership to be eligible for Championship medals/ribbons (U20, Senior, Senior/Master, Master, or Road, Trail & Cross Country membership).
- Athletes must hold a competitive membership from BC Athletics or another Athletics Canada branch to be eligible for prize money.
