- Qualifying athletes may apply for a limited number of complimentary entries, subject to availability. Standards must be achieved in the previous 12 months:

Men: 15:00 (5K) or 30:30 (10K) Women: 17:30 (5K) or 35:30 (10K)

Plus the overall <u>2015 BC Road Race Series</u> leaders following race #11 (Sandcastle City Classic 10K).
