Athletes wishing to be considered for selection to the Aboriginal Team BC (ATBC) to compete at the 2008 North American Indigenous Games, August 3 – 10/08, Cowichan Valley, BC must:

1. Be of Aboriginal Descent (Status and Non-Status First Nations, Inuit, Métis)
2. Take part in the 2008 BC Athletics sanctioned events and must compete in the events they wish to be considered for;
3. Be a member in good standing with the Aboriginal Sports and Recreation Association of BC (ASRA), for more information regarding ASRA Membership visit website www.asra.ca and click on 'Membership' to receive details for the registration process or contact the ASRA office at 1-866-544-8172
4. Be an active competitive member of BC Athletics in good standing in the 2008 season

Selection Criteria

- Registered participant in a sanctioned BC Athletics Event in the current 2008 Outdoor season
- Athletes will be considered for selection based on their Best Legal Performance in the 2008 Outdoor Season

Selection Criteria:

- **Head Coach (1):** Hold a minimum NCCP Level 2 Athletics Coaching Certificate
- **Assistant Coaches (2):** Hold a minimum NCCP Level 1 Athletics Coaching Certificate
- Submit a Coach Application Form, available through www.asra.ca and click on 'Coaches' to receive details for the registration process or contact the ASRA office at 1-866-544-8172
- Submit a successful Criminal Record Check
- Submit a coaching resume with three references
- Coaches that are not certified but still want to apply will need to fill out a Coach Exemption form. Contact ASRA Office for more information.
