

BC Athletics Level 2 Officials Travel Bursary

Five Travel Bursaries – Maximum \$200 each.

This is an incentive program for Level 2 Officials seeking mentorship/evaluation opportunities at designated Track & Field Meets in British Columbia. This is a one-time bursary for a first time upgrade from Level 2 to Level 3. The travel bursary is for travel outside the official's zone and is at the discretion of the selection committee.

This program will be evaluated on a yearly basis.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Member of B.C. Athletics.
2. Priority will be given to candidates who are seeking mentorship opportunities to facilitate transition from a Level 2 Official to a Level 3 Official.
3. The applicant must have 1 year of experience as a Level 2 Official.
4. Priority will be given to Level 2 Officials who are on the upgrade list

Procedures:

1. An application will be forwarded to the BC Athletics Officials Committee.
2. The applicant must identify one of the designated T & F Meets for the mentorship/evaluation.
3. The application must be received by the committee in advance of the intended meet.
4. A senior official must endorse the application.
5. The B.C. Athletics Officials Committee will assist in coordinating the mentorship opportunities for successful candidates.
6. The B.C. Athletics Officials Bursary Selection Committee will notify successful candidates.
7. A cheque will be forwarded upon completion of the assignment. The candidate must notify the chairperson of the officials committee.
