The Championship portion of the event is open to all Junior, Senior, Masters and Road & Trail members of BC Athletics. Memberships must be received by April 13, 2012 in order to be eligible.

Championship Awards

Championship Medals and Prize Money of \$200, \$100, and \$50 will be presented to:

- The first 3 eligible finishers, men and women, overall.

Championship Ribbons will be presented to:

- The first 3 eligible finishers, men and women, in each age category: 18-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, ... 100+

High Performance Athletes

- Prize Money: \$3,000/\$1,000/\$500 to the top-3 men and women overall.
\$2,000/\$1,000/\$750/\$500/\$250 to the top-5 Canadians.
\$750/\$500/\$250 to the top-3 masters.
