2010 Canadian Junior Track & Field Championships Cdn World Junior Team Trials Combined Events - Toronto, ON – June 12-13, 2010 All Other Events - Moncton, NB - July 2-4, 2010

Overview

The Canadian Junior Track & Field Championships will be the Selection competition for the 2010 World Junior Track & Field Championships to be held in Moncton, NB, July 19 to 25th, 2010. This will provide an opportunity to compete on the 2010 World Junior T&F Facility. The Cdn Championships are a critical step towards this major event.

BC Athletics will provide support to those qualifying athletes – dependent on final budget (see General Criteria for Funding & Team Selection and the team selection criteria and standards.)

- Maximum Team Size: 30 athletes plus staff – **Note:** Team Size will be dependent on the funding available and finalization of the 2010/11 BCA budget.

- The Cdn Junior Race Walk Championships are being held as part of the Cdn Junior Track & Field Championships in Moncton July 2,3,4.

Canadian Championship Entries - Travel–Accommodation & Meals

- BC Athletics will do the entries for all BC Team athletes
- Travel to Combined Events - Toronto: BC Athletics will book flights for the selected athletes and team staff.
- Travel to Jnr Championships-Moncton: BC Athletics has blocked seats for the BC Team Athletes and Coaches for travel to Moncton, NB. It is expected that Team athletes and staff will use these bookings. Team Travel Days: Depart Wednesday, June 30/Return Monday, July 5. Details will be available from the BC Athletics Office
- Accommodation – BC Athletics has blocked accommodation for the BC Team. Athletes are responsible for their cost of Accommodation and Meals. Details to be confirmed.

Important Information for Athletes, Coaches and Parents/Guardians:

- **BC Junior Track & Field Championship Participation:**
 - In accepting selection to the BC Junior Track & Field Team, athletes commit to competing in the BC Junior T&F Championships. This commitment will take the form of a signed agreement as part of the Athlete Declaration. (Exceptions as per the program criteria). The 2010 BC Junior Track & Field Championships on July 16 to 18 (as part of the BC Championships Jamboree) is being held after the Cdn Jnr Championships because of their early date and in support of our work to extend the BC competition season.
- **BC Athlete Assistance 2010/2011 (BC Carding)**
 - Athletes wishing to be considered for BC Athlete Assistance (BC Carding) must take part in the 2010 BC Junior Track & Field Championships unless they are:
 1. Competing on a Cdn or BC Team
 2. Injured or Ill – ONLY a letter from a Medical Doctor will be accepted. This must be presented prior to the start of the Championships
 3. Domestic Affliction – defined as a personal or family tragedy, incident or emergency that does not allow you to attend the Championships. Notification must be received prior to the start of the Championships unless this is not possible.
 4. Education, Exam or Graduation commitment

Athlete Declarations are due in at the BC Athletics office by:

- Combined Events – Tuesday, May 25/10
- Walks and Track & Field Events – Monday, June 7/10

Guidelines

Athletes wishing to be considered for selection to the BC Junior Team to compete at the National Junior Track and Field Championships in Toronto, ON for Combined Events June 12, 13/10; and Moncton, NB for all other events July 2, 3, 4/10 must:

1. Meet the BC Athletics General Criteria for Funding Support and Selection;
2. Provide accurate and legal results from sanctioned Track and Field meets during the Windows of Opportunity as outlined above.
3. Athletes must meet the Selection Criteria which includes the following standards:

Selection Criteria

Athletes will be considered for selection as follows:

1. Athletes will be ranked highest to lowest by percentage relative to the selection standards based on performances in the windows of opportunity.
2. Athletes will be considered by their percentage above the standard in descending order until the team has been comprised.
3. Other athletes may be considered by nearness to the standard and medal potential based on the results during the windows of opportunity.

NOTE: Due to limitations in available funding, achieving the funding standard does not guarantee selection. **Entry standards or qualifying to enter the Canadian Championship is separate from the BC Team Standards and does not require achieving the BC Team Standards.**

Standards are based on the average of the previous 5 years of the 3rd place Canadian Junior National Championships Performance in each event. If necessary the standards are adjusted by the Event Group Representatives so as to reflect the expected performance levels of Junior Athletes on BC Teams.

Please Note:

- * The steeplechase event is 2000m for women and at 3000m for men.
 - **Note:** Equivalent 2000m S/C standard for Men was added May 21/10.
- ** Shot Put – Men – High School Weight Equivalent
- *** Discus – Men – High School Weight Equivalent
- **** Hammer – Men – High School Weight Equivalent
- ***** Walks Women & Men Equivalent Standards: Although a 5km equivalent standard is provided for, male and female walks athletes must have completed a 10km walk event in the 2010 season (Feb 15 to June 13) to be eligible for selection.
- ***** Decathlon – Equivalent Standards are provided for using the Technical Specifications for: High School and Senior (20+) age groups.
