## I. Overview

In 2014, the committee met primarily through email discussions. They will also be meeting face-to-face after the 2014 BC Athletics AGM on Sunday, December 7, 2014. Most correspondence related to feedback on the following items:

- 2013 Athlete Assistance
- 2014 BC Team Selection Criteria
- 2014 Annual Athlete Awards
- 2015 Athletics Canada Rule Changes
- 2015-2018 BC Athletics Jamboree Host

## II. Outcomes

- a. BC Athletics selected 37 athletes for funding;
- b. BC Athletics selected 103 athletes onto BC Teams:
  - i. 30 BC Senior
  - ii. 33 BC Junior
  - iii. 25 BC Legion Youth
  - iv. 15 BC Midget 15
- c. BC Athletics completed voting on 2014 Annual Athlete of the Year Awards;
- d. BC Athletics completed feedback on 2015 Athletics Canada Rule Changes (to be voted on at AGM)
- e. BC Athletics completed selection of hosts for 2015-2016 and 2017-2018 BC Athletics Track & Field Jamboree Championships.

## III. Challenges

- a. With committee members all over the province, finding a time to meet was limited;
- b. There is currently no Chair of the Track & Field Committee which is much needed in order to drive discussion on initiatives brought forth by BC Athletics Staff;
- c. There are positions on the Track & Field Committee that need to be filled;
- d. There is currently no athlete input on the Track & Field Committee;

## III. Recommendations

- a. The Track & Field Committee will primarily use electronic correspondence (email) for decisions on annual items (ie. voting on awards, feedback on standards). The annual face-to-face meeting will be reserved for important initiatives moving forward to the next year;
- b. BC Athletics will look to recruit a Chair for the Track & Field Committee;
- c. BC Athletics will work with the Chair to recruit committee members for the Track & Field Committee;

- d. BC Athletics will work with the BC Athletics athlete reps to create an Athlete Representative for the Track & Field Committee.

IV. Initiatives for 2015

- a. BC Athletics will work with new Chair to create and complete 2015 initiatives after the face-to-face meeting in December
