

Report to BC Athletics Annual Report 2022-2023

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The Coach Education Report connects to the Technical Leadership Pillar of the Strategic Plan. It covers NCCP Coach Education Courses, Professional Development Opportunities, NCCP Coach Evaluations, and Coach Developer (Learning Facilitators and Evaluators) Training.

## 1. NCCP Coach Education

# 1.1 Overview:

Our NCCP Coach Education courses are context dependent and consists of the following courses. <u>(Click here for more information)</u>

- **Run Jump Throw Wheel** for coaches in grassroots track and field (covered in the Introductory Programs Report)
- Foundations of Coaching in Athletics theory modules common to both Sport and Club Coach
- Sport Coach a multi-event course for coaches with introductory level athletes
- Club Coach an event specific course for coaches with intermediate level athletes
- Performance Coach an event specific course for coaches with high performance athletes
- Road Running Leader Course for leaders in community road running programs
- Make Ethical Decisions (MED) a multi-sport NCCP course required for all coaches
- Managing Conflict a multi-sport NCCP course required for NCCP Performance Coach

## 1.2 Updates

- **Road Running:** A new road running leader course for community run leaders was developed and piloted in Terrace. We will be training more facilitators and delivering them this fall.
- New event groups: A wheelchair racing curriculum has been added for club and performance coach. We are working on training new facilitators to delivery these modules. Combined events have also been added to performance coach, and coaches can complete their evaluation in this event group rather than one per event group.
- **Performance Coach:** We hosted the largest Performance Coach yet with 54 coaches (30 male, 24 female) in 5 event groups (sprints, jumps, throws, endurance and combined events) across 8 branches, including 33 from BC, 35 athlete demonstrators, and 4 new BC facilitators trained. As a pre-req to performance coach several coaches were certified in Club Coach, expanding the pool of qualified coaches for several BC teams.
- Based on feedback from this course and others, it was recently revised and two courses as are hosted in Ontario and New Brunswick this fall. BCA is offering \$700 travel grants to attend
  - i. updated curriculum

- **ii.** 3 less multi-sport courses requirements to be trained/certified.
- **iii.** Coaches can also sign up for a cohort to complete the in person training, e-learning, and evaluation with a cohort over a year and be part of a collaborative/thought sharing what's ap group.
- **iv.** Flexibility within the competition evaluation that can happen at select provincial meets and not just inter-provincial.
- v. Full updates here
- **Sport and Club Coach** are also currently being revised. While the final curriculum is still TBD, the hope is that we create an more well rounded curriculum and have a variety of options pending coach commitment level. I.e., a basic course for short term volunteers and advanced options for coaches wanting to expand their knowledge at the development level instead of directly progressing to performance coach if not applicable for them.
- **Sport Coach + RJTW.** We developed a sport coach + RJTW 2 day technical course, particularly for smaller communities where coaches may coach a wide range of age and skill levels.
- **New Position:** Hailey Kjaer started in January 2023 with a portion of her role to support Coach Education and has been a great help to support more coaches getting trained and certified!
- **Coach Planning:** We have created a draft annual coach education calendar to be used as a guide each year of when courses will be happening in which area. It is currently being shared to with our coach developer team and host and will be shared publically once confirmed. Clubs should fill out the <u>host interest form</u> if wanting to host. Hosting clubs receive 2 complimentary spots to our courses.

- **Club Coach:** Submit a Portfolio, Practice Observation
- **Performance Coach:** Submit a Portfolio, Practice Observation, Competition Observation (can be at select provincial competitions now as well)
