




Marketing & Communications

Social Media

- Instagram (most successful)
 - New initiative: Athlete of the Week, averaging engagement of 120 impressions per post
 - Averaging 143 impressions per post
 - 484 new followers since Dec 31
 - Averaging 6.07% follower growth rate, expecting to hit 5K followers by end of February
 - Averaging 3.38% engagement rate
 - Male dominated following (66.07%) and Vancouver dominated following (27% next highest city is Victoria at 7% for reference)
- Facebook
 - 2.6k followers, averaging 9 impressions per post, low engagement (<1%)
- Twitter
 - 2772 followers, averaging 142 views per post, lowest engagement
- Future platforms to be considered: TikTok, YouTube







