| <b>Parking:</b>        | Parking available at Serauxman Stadium, Nanaimo Aquatic + Ice Centres. Parking at the track for officials and volunteers only.   |

| <b>Club Packages</b>   | Registration packages will be available for pick up at the Registration Table in front of the concession by 8:30am Saturday and Sunday mornings.   |
| <b>Facilities:</b>     | Class 2 WA certified 8 lane track. Washrooms and change rooms located under the north grandstand and at the NTFC clubhouse. A concession and food trucks will be available.  |
| <b>Bib Numbers:</b>    | Numbered bibs will be assigned to all athletes to be worn for all events.<br>Track events = front      Field events = Back   |
| <b>Events:</b>         | <b>Field Events</b> are limited to 3 attempts only for all U14 age groups. In U16 and older, 8 finalists in the combined group will get 3 additional attempts.<br><br><b>Track Events</b> will start with the Open Age Categories at the posted times.<br>Competition order: Masters, Senior, U20, U18, U16 to JD 9 with females first in each age category, followed by the males.<br><br>The exception to the above will be the hurdle events which will run in order of the longest to shortest distances and the highest to lowest settings at each distance. Unless noted otherwise, all track events will be Timed Finals. |
| <b>Officials:</b>      | VIAA Clubs are asked to ensure that volunteers are in place at the posted event start times.   |
| <b>Awards:</b>         | Ribbons will be given out for 1st to 8th place for JD athletes and top 3 for U16 and up.   |
| <b>Results:</b>        | Results will be available live and also be posted on NTFC website and Trackie.   |
