Notice Regarding Board of Director Elections

Chris has served as the Director of Finance for the past year, having been appointed following the resignation of the previous Director. He is a Chartered Professional Accountant (CPA) with over 10 years of experience in accounting and consulting with KPMG, where he worked with both private and not-for-profit clients. Chris currently serves as the Director of Finance for Opus Art Supplies. Over the past year, he has brought a thoughtful and analytical perspective to the financial oversight of BC Athletics and looks forward to continuing to strengthen the organization's financial governance.

Brittany Therrien

Brittany has served as a Director-at-Large for the past 1.5 years, following her appointment to the Board. A practicing lawyer called to the bar in 2018, Brittany's practice focuses on workplace law, including labour, employment, occupational health and safety, human rights, and privacy. She also conducts investigations into misconduct in both workplace and sport environments. Brittany's expertise is particularly relevant to BC Athletics given the evolving landscape of Safe Sport, and she has provided valuable insight and guidance on these matters.
