British Columbia proudly celebrated three World Athletics Champions (Camryn Rogers, Ethan Katzberg and Evan Dunfee), two World Para Athletics Champions (Greg Stewart and Nate Tucker), and numerous additional podium performances (Jerome Blake and Julie Hanes). Their achievement highlighted the excellence of depth and talent in our province.
