ZONE REP INFORMATION

NEW BC Athletics will select **2 (two)** Zone Reps per BC Summer Games Zone teams.

The role of Zone Reps includes:

- a. Promote the 2026 BC Summer Games participation within their zones with particular attention to events in which non-BCA members may participate (i.e. high school events) and BC Athletics member athletes within your zone. BC Athletics to provide promotional materials. Media lists are also available on the BC Games Resource website and include sample press releases and promotional ideas.
- b. Assist in the recruitment and selection of Zone Team Coaches including the head coach and assistant coaches with the assistance of Provincial Advisor (PA).
- c. Lead, with assistance of the Provincial Advisor, the selection of zone team athletes for their zone team. The Provincial Advisor (PA) will provide a workbook and instructions to assist with this.
- d. With the assistance of the Provincial Advisors (PA), manage the registration of all athletes, coaches and adult supervisors. A registration package will be provided in spring 2026 by the BC Games society along with information sessions.
- e. Collect registration fees for all athletes within their zone. Fees can be found in the 2026 BC Summer Games Technical Package and will be \$250.00 CDN + GST for each athlete. This fee will include a uniform, registration into the games as well as an opening ceremonies item unique to Athletics (TBA).

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible as a BC Summer Games Zone Rep, applicants must:

- a. Must have a BC Athletics membership. Those who do not have a current membership must take out a [Sport Leadership Membership](#). [Please click here for more information on BCA memberships](#). The BCA Sport Leadership Membership includes a mandatory Criminal Records Check (CRC) and completion of the [NCCP SafeSport Training Course](#).
- b. Agree to attend the games. Zone reps may choose to attend the games in the capacity of an Adult Supervisor or team coach. Attending the games includes travelling to and from the games with their zone team, residing with their team in BC Games accommodations, and acting in a supervisory capacity throughout the duration of the games.
- c. Familiarize themselves and agree to abide by the BC Summer Games “Culture of the Games and Safety at the Games,” and “Codes of Conduct” noted in the **BC Summer Games General Rules** [here](#).
