Strategic Plan Activities

Athlete Development

- I. Club Programs
 - Track Rascals
 - Have received increased requests from clubs for training to start Track Rascal programs. Working with each region to host RJTW courses. Will soon begin work to recruit and train a Coach Developer for each club, to help increase coach training opportunities
 - Clubs continuing to offer Track Rascal events within existing meets
 - Junior Development
 - List of meets approved for JD Crests and Award standards increased to 31
 - Working with individual clubs to help increase program capacity
 - Survey regarding Age Group names was conducted
- II. Recreation Programs
 - Hosted first BC Athletics Spring Break Track & Field Camp
 - 24 registrants from Metro Vancouver region
 - Participants engaged with local National Team athletes each day
 - o Track & Field camps were also hosted by member clubs and external organizations
 - o Continuing to develop multi-sport partnerships for greater RJTW delivery opportunities
- III. School Programs
 - Continuing to promote and deliver RJTW Direct Deliveries
 - o Continuing to promote and deliver RJTW Teacher Pro-D Workshops
 - Continuing to promote and deliver PE Student Leadership Workshops
 Difficulty: There are limited instructors available to deliver program during school hours
 - Continuing to develop framework to connect schools with their local clubs for networking, coach mentoring, club promotion, and Athletic promotion opportunities

Technical Leadership

- I. Coaches
 - RJTW Coach Developer Upgrading to be hosted in April to familiarize current coach developers with updates to the RJTW courses and evaluations requirements
 - RJTW Coach Developer training to be scheduled for those interested in becoming Learning Facilitators and Coach Evaluators; targeting Fall 2019
