# BC Athletics Cross Country Committee Report 2019 Prepared by Technical Director Road & Cross Country

#### Cross Country Series

The Interior Running Associations Cross Country Series, numbers were healthy this year, with participation up over most of the events. Series participation was up 100 runners over 2018. The schedule for 2020 has been set and posted in the BCA Calendar of events.

The Lower Mainland Series numbers were down slightly from last year. The biggest challenge for the series is not working together to promote each other, and leadership within the group to bring them together. The series is looking for someone to score the Junior portion of the series.

### BC XC Championships

The Prairie Inn Harriers Club hosted the BC Cross Country Championships this year (and next) at Beaver Lake in Saanich on Vancouver Island. The Club did an excellent job hosting the event and set out a challenging, technical course. Feedback received from the athletes and coaches were positive. There are some small tweaks the Technical Director will work on with the Host to improve the event 2020.

The revenue for the event was low with the loss of CanWest athletes (see participation below), the club lost money hosting the Championship. The host committee has asked for a \$3 increase in registration fees across all age groups / timelines. See the pricing for the events in the Lower Mainland Series below.

The Technical Director is also in discussion with local USport Coaches to explore opportunities to co-host the BC XC with a CanWest Championship in the coming years.

# BC Team Selection

There were no issues this year with the revised criteria for BC Team selection. The criteria was clear who would be selected and what it took to be selected. 90% of athletes that were offered team positions, accepted them. The ones that did not accept, did not compete at ACXC. Main reason for decline of the team position was the athlete was ending their season short of ACXC

Challenge in some categories, U20 mainly, to have best pool of athletes to select from. The athletes that were competing at CanWest and not at BCXC, needed to declare interest in the BC Team. The low number of declarations, limited the pool of eligible athletes.

The BC Team athletes were happy with the BC Team program and feel it is important step in athlete development.

### National Championships

The event was hosted by a hybrid committee, with representation from a number of Clubs in the Langley area. The event was very technically solid, running on time, accurately and safely.

Feedback has been mixed, mainly due to the familiarity that athletes and coaches have with the course / venue. With High Schools running here three weeks prior and provincials on the same course for 2017 / 2018.

BC Athletics has asked to be part of the debrief between AC and the Host Committee.

#### Pan Am Cross Country Cup

Pan Am Championships will be held Saturday, February 29 at the Westin Bear Mountain Golf Resort & Spa. The Hosting Committee has let BCA know that they currently have 8 nations registered with a couple of more possibly registering.

Other events that have been added to the day are a CanAm Masters Challenge, challenge between Canadian and American runners, where any member of their federation can score in the competition. Master athletes that are not a member are welcome to run, but will not score. There is a 5k All-Comers event open to the public and a separate Youth race for athletes' in grades K to 8.
