Organizational Capacity

- I. Communication & Marketing
 - Have increased use of social media to promote BC Athletics introductory programs, including Junior Development Awards Banquet and BC Cross Country Championships have also seen increased social media content by some member clubs
 - Collaborating with Athletics Canada on potential updates to RJTW course manuals.
- II. Volunteers & Recognition
 - In collaboration with office staff and former summer intern (Kenny Ho), have developed an online campaign to create greater awareness of and excitement around the BC Athletics Annual Awards Banquet
 - In collaboration with office staff have otherwise been organizing various aspects of the BC Athletics Annual Awards Banquet to ensure a successful event
- II. Partnerships
 - Continuing to partner with BC Wheelchair Basketball for the use of sports chairs to deliver RJTW Wheel module
 - Liaising with the Sport 4 Life Society to help support the “Coaches Mentoring Elementary School Teachers” (CMEST) project, through communication with clubs in project regions
 - Liaising with Pacific Sport: Fraser Valley to help support their Xplore Sportz and Beyond the Bells programs which include an introduction to Athletics
