## Survey Results

  - All clubs willing to work collaboratively with other clubs, the officials committee and BCA staff to create a meaningful competition calendar in 2021
  - All clubs support the idea of a lower mainland Fraser Valley Series
  - o 4 Clubs requested Officials Training/Education (Kajaks, VOC, Thunderbirds, Mustangs)
  - West Vancouver TFC requires facility upgrades to host meets

- Vancouver Thunderbirds to host meets following UBC Varsity meets and would like to capitalize on timing being in place by hosting track events.
- Vancouver Thunderbirds membership mainly comprised of JD and High School Endurance Athletes
- Vancouver Thunderbirds will host throws if necessary, but hammer and discus are more complicated to host
- Depending on rental rates and events, Vancouver Thunderbirds may host meets from Swangard but may need to rent equipment depending on events
- Vancouver Thunderbirds are pushing for parents to become officials and may use officials present at UBC Varsity Meets
- Vancouver Thunderbirds would appreciate leads on Sponsorships

# Considerations

- Time and Duration: How long will meets be (some events take longer than others)? How many meets can take place in one day? How frequently should competitions occur?
- Finances: How much will it cost to host the meets (e.g. Track meets have a higher monetary expense due to timing)? What should the entry fee be? Is there other revenue generating options? Can clubs receive a subsidy from BCA?
- Resources: Do we have enough Officials? Can we host all meets without putting too much strain on the Officials? Do we have enough equipment (e.g. each athlete has their own throwing implement)?
- Restrictions: Different cities have different jurisdictions
- COVID-19 Protocols: Officials depend on host clubs to implement and enforce appropriate COVID-19 protocols.
- How do we make meets fun and enjoyable for JD athletes?
