Our goal is to raise \$20,000 to dedicate a bench in Stanley Park in Ivor's name and to make a donation to the West Van Place for Sport to have Ivor's name included on the "gold" list of donors at the new Harry Jerome Oval to be built at West Van High School. Note: Many different memorials for Ivor were considered and discussed. Some of the other ideas were to create an annual scholarship fund for a student, getting a trail in Stanley Park, or the track at Brockton Oval, named after Ivor, creating an award in Ivor's name for the Vancouver Marathon, creating an annual run in Ivor's name. For various reasons these ideas were not possible or supported. In the

end we thought the bench was appropriate because Ivor spent so much time running and coaching in Stanley Park, and the memorial plaque was appropriate because Ivor lived most of his adult life in West Vancouver and was a teacher at West Vancouver High School for many years where his 1969 x-country team won the provincial title.
