



Officials' Travel Subsidy Program

Purpose:

This program is designed for those Officials wishing to advance to Levels 2 and 3 and who reside in a community that does not provide the development opportunity required by the Official in order to upgrade their qualifications. This program offers a \$200 subsidy that would normally be used to offset the cost of accommodation and travel.

Structure:

- There will be five subsidies available in each calendar year.
- Only one grant is available per applicant per year.
- Priority in any year will be given to applicants who have not received a previous subsidy.
- Although it can be used for accommodation and travel this grant would be in addition to the regular travel funding that is available from BCA.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicant must have current BCA membership.
- Applicant must have at least 1 year of experience as a Certified Official.
- Applicant must have some or all of the credits required to upgrade to the next level.

Procedures:

1. The application form (see below) will be sent to the BC Athletics Officials' Committee representative, Greg Nicol. If approved by him, he will forward the application to the Committee.
2. The application must be received and approved in advance of the intended meet.
3. The Committee will assist in coordinating the mentorship opportunities or the evaluation for the successful candidate.
4. The representative will notify successful candidates of the approval of their application prior to the meet.
5. The applicant will submit an expense form including receipts to the BCA Officials' Committee.
