Officiating Q & A Answers

A1

a) The athlete not jumping forfeits any claim to a higher place. The remaining athlete is declared the winner regardless of whether he attempts that height (Rule #181.9e)

A2

a) and b). The Torso does not include the head, neck, arms, legs, hands or feet. (Rule #165.2)

A3

c) Javelin. It shall be considered a failure if an athlete in the course of a trial touches with any part of his body the lines which mark the runway. (Rule #187.14d)

In Long Jump an athlete shall not be regarded to have failed if he runs outside the white lines marking the runway at any point (Rule #185.3a)

In Pole Vault it is not a failure if an Athlete runs outside the white lines marking the runway at any point. (Rule #183.2 *Note i*)
