**2020 BC Athletics Annual General Meeting – August 22, 2020**

**Track & Field**

Discussion, Recommendations, Assistance in 2020 on the following facility initiatives:

- City of Vancouver Track & Field Facility – completion of priorities for competition, training and recreational level facilities. Work to commence in late 2020 and into 2021.
- Maple Ridge Secondary School T&F Facility – further discussion on upgrades and relocation of ancillary equipment. 2020 BC Summer Games cancelled with Maple Ridge rescheduled to 2024.
- Coquitlam – New Hammer/Discus Cage completed and approved by BC Athletics
- North Delta Secondary School – Facility design and development to proceed.
- Apple Bowl – Kelowna – continued recommendations on Hammer/Discus Cage

**Federal Government via Athletics Canada – COVID Facility Funding Application.**

- Notification from Athletics Cd on this Fed Govt initiative - BC Athletics facilitated a call out to clubs/facility owners that we knew were looking to upgrade/build T&F Facilities. **The following responded and were submitted thru AC to Fed Govt. No notification yet on what proposals were selected for support:**
  1. Parksville – Ballenas Secondary School – Track Build
  2. McCloud Park – Langley – Communications Network Project
  3. Victoria – Centennial Stadium – Equipment upgrade and replacement
    - Notified after submissions that the Fed Govt removed Equipment as an eligible upgrade.

4. Burnaby - Swangard Stadium – upgrading • Field Event (runways and throwing area upgrades)
5. City of Vancouver – Vancouver Tech – T&F Facility upgrade/build
6. Kamloops – Hillside Stadium – Track resurfacing
7. North Vancouver School District – Sutherland Track upgrade/build
8. Oak Bay Secondary School T&F Facility – consultation, review and recommendations re: 2021 Canadian Jeux de la Francophonie Games
9. UBC – Track & Field facility resurfacing/upgrading
10. West Vancouver Secondary School – T&F facility rebuild

BC accounted for 9 of the 21 project applications submitted to the Federal Government (10 of 24 submitted to Athletics Canada)

**Consultants and Designers** – provision of a list to facility owners and city/municipal governments and school boards.

**Technical Standards** – provision of information on request. Reference the World Athletics 2019 Track & Field Facilities Manual and World Athletics Competition Rules

**Technical Facility Reviews** – undertaken by the Technical Facilities Sub-committee of the BCA Officials Committee. The sub-committee conducts a scheduled review of facilities and upon request and provides consulting on the design and layout of facilities so as to meet compliance with BC Athletics and/or IAAF requirements for competitions, recognition of performances, records and suitability for the level of competition being considered for the facility.
