

PacificSport Fraser Valley	Typically referred to as the Fraser Valley, centralized in Langley, covers parts of southeast Greater Vancouver, from Surrey out as far as Hope.	Abbotsford, Chilliwack, Hope, Langley, Maple Ridge, Mission, Pitt Meadows, Surrey, White Rock
PacificSport Interior BC	Typically referred to as BC's Interior, and centralized in Kamloops, covers an area stretching as far north as 100 Mile House, as far east as Revelstoke, and as far south as Lillooet.	100 Mile House, Clearwater, Kamloops, Lillooet, Merritt, Revelstoke, Salmon Arm, Sicamous
PacificSport Okanagan	Typically referred to as the Okanagan, and centralized in Kelowna, covers an area in south-central BC stretching as far north as Enderby and as far south as Osoyoos.	Enderby, Kelowna, Osoyoos, Peachland, Penticton, Summerland, Vernon, Winfield
PacificSport Vancouver Island	Typically referred to as Northern Vancouver Island, and centralized in Nanaimo, covers everything on Vancouver Island northwest of Langford.	Campbell River, Comox, Courtenay, Duncan, Nanaimo, Parksville, Port Alberni, Qualicum, Tofino




