### Program (Federal Govt) eligibility requirements for all applicants:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the "Immigration and Refugee Protection Act";
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations; and
- Not be a family member or related to members of the BC Athletics Board of Directors or Staff.
  - Note: International Students are not eligible to be employed through this program. Recent immigrants are eligible if they are Canadian Citizens or permanent residents.

#### Job Responsibilities:

Working with and under the guidance of BC Athletics Staff (Sabina Nettey, Introductory Programs Coordinator, Jennifer Brown, Coaching Education Coordinator and Brian McCalder, President/CEO), the Summer Staff will assist and as appropriate be the lead o:

- 1. Assist in the Planning, on-line and direct delivery of the Run Jump Throw Wheel (RJTW) Program to children / youth.
- 2. Assist in the development, delivery and recruitment for RJTW Instructor Training Courses.
- 3. Tracking participation in RJTW Programs, updating and tracking of Instructor qualifications in the CAC and Coaching databases.
- 4. Review & updating the RJTW materials/AV aids for courses & Prog promotion.
- 5. Assisting in the planning, filming and editing of the Run Jump Throw Wheel activity videos schedule to put into production the Spring of 2022.
- 6. Planning, coordination and promotion of 2022 Club Youth Camps.
- 7. Work with Primary Schools to schedule and promote RJTW delivery, instructors. Development opportunities for teachers to deliver the RJTW program in the Fall of 2022.
- 8. Work with Secondary Schools through their Leadership Course to train RJTW instructors to deliver Run Jump Throw Wheel programs in Elementary Schools.

- 9. Work with Secondary Schools to create pathway for identification and development of athletes in the para and able-bodied streams in athletics.
- 10. Coach Education helping with coach developer engagement, verifying coach qualifications (for minimum standards), mentorship research.
- 11. Development and coordination of speaker series for athletes, coaches and officials, schools and general public.
- 12. Development, coordination and promotion of coaching professional development courses and tracking delivery. Assist in the development of coach mentorship programs. Manage feedback process of professional development.
- 13. Assist in the recruitment, engagement, online training and development of Officials and the tracking program of qualifications and scheduling.
- 14. Explore opportunities for additional revenue generation through donation campaign, sponsorship and e-commerce strategies.
- 15. Updating BC Athletics website content and developing social media content.
- 16. Assisting with the implementation of the Tactics/Actions as part of the BC Athletics 2022-2024 Strategic Plan.
- 17. Other duties as may be assigned from time to time.
