The Reactime System will be used for sprints and sprint relays at the National Track and Field Championships June 23-26, 2022 and July 27-30, 2023, and at other Lower Mainland meets in June 2022 (TBD). Athletes will work with National Level Start Line Officials who will be key Officials for National Championships. Official start times (Reactime data) will be displayed for a series of starts for each athlete.
