If you are registered through an Athletics Club, please ask your Club Registrar to register you soon as one of the benefits of membership (for Levels 2 and up) is the receipt of an IAAF Book of Competition Rules. We hope to be distributing the new books in February (Competition Rules 2018/2019) so want as many Officials as possible to be registered by then. If you have a membership with BC Athletics through another category (Athlete, Club Executive etc.) please don't forget to also check the box for Official.

Does the Club to which you belong have an Officials' Page, Information or Yearly Award? This sort of recognition helps our numbers grow and also gives you amazing volunteers the acknowledgement and appreciation that you so richly deserve. Please encourage your Club Executive to add 'Officials' Information' to their website.

Several of our Provincial Officials have sent us queries about the requirement for Criminal Record checks and the process involved. Key Policies for Officiating in BC

The following are policies for officiating in BC that were covered at the Annual Officials Meeting on October 21, 2017. Please see any member of the Officials Committee if you have questions, concerns or extenuating circumstances that warrant consideration.

Meet Credits

Only officiating at sanctioned track and field events count for meet credits. Sanctioning can be from BC Athletics or equivalent organizations in other jurisdictions.

- Unsanctioned meets do not count for upgrading, recognition item or travel reimbursement (e.g., Special Olympics, some elementary school events). Sanctioning ensures insurance coverage along with a minimum standard for meet organization, competition and officiating requirements.
- Workshops do not count as meet credits for upgrading, recognition item or travel reimbursement purposes.

Recognition Item

The recognition item is designed as a thank you for those active officials who help officiate track and field meets. To qualify for the recognition item, an official must obtain a minimum of 15 credits at sanctioned track and field meets in the year between September 1 and August 31. Credits for a recognition item cannot be carried forward across years. Recognition items are not for purchase.

Travel Expenses

Expenses can be claimed for travel to sanctioned meets in BC. Expense claims should be submitted within 30 days. Travel to meets outside of BC are determined and approved (in advance of meet) on a case-by-case basis by the Officials Committee.

Travel expense claims for Meets within your own area or zone do not require pre-approval. Travel to a Meet outside of your zone does require pre-approval.

To claim travel expenses, you must be a full time official at the corresponding meet. Officials cannot claim travel expenses for meets in which they also intend to coach, parent and/or compete.

Carpooling or sharing rides is strongly encouraged where feasible. A rationale for travelling as an individual must be provided (if other officials from your area are travelling to the same meet).
