Workshops

We know that many will be pleased to hear that we are offering a Level 2 Workshop in the Lower Mainland on September 9th from 10:00am until approximately 3:00pm. The workshop is being held in the pavilion at Bear Creek Park, Surrey.

The Level 2 course is a 5 – 6 hour workshop and is required for advancement to Level 2 in the Athletics Canada National Officials Certification program. Rules and best practices for all branches of Athletics are covered in a lecture/discussion format. It is conducted entirely in the classroom, and there will be some paperwork. The Registration fee covers costs of handouts, and a current IAAF Rulebook. Registration fees for BCA members is \$25+GST / others \$30+GST.
