IAAF Rule Books (2018-19)

The IAAF Rule Books (2018-19) are coming! They will look different this time. The BC Officials Committee is working with the other provinces to print the rule books based on a model used in Alberta. The rule books will focus on Chapter 5—covering the technical rules. They will be cirlox bound so you can flip pages for easier reference. Referee, Starter's Assistants and Race Walk cards will be included in the book. A very nice feature for anyone who needs to use these cards! The rulebooks will be printed in colour, as there are explanatory notes in green text—very helpful notes for understanding and applying the rules. The rule books will be available in mid-February and will be provided to all active Level 2 officials and above. Please remember that you must be registered with BC Athletics in order to receive your copy of the rulebook.

Start Dates for Officials

Later this month, we will be asking you to confirm your start date (e.g., date of your Level 1 workshop), particularly if you migrated to BC after officiating in another province.
