

# Officials Certification Pathway

## GENERALISTS

### Level 1 Official --- Local

#### Role

- Officiates at local meets
- Active member of officiating team

#### Requirements

- Officials 101 Online Training Module (60 mins)
- Exposure to Throws, Horizontal Jumps, Vertical Jumps, Track Events



#### Note:

Level 1 is for those with no experience in Athletics; those with experience proceed to Level 2

### Level 2 Official --- Regional

#### Role

- Officiates at regional meets
- Make some officiating decisions under supervision

#### Requirements

- Officials 201 Online Training Module (60 mins)
- 1 Year of experience as an Official
- Experience: 8 sessions - 2 sessions each of Throws, Horizontal Jumps, Vertical Jumps, Track Events
- Confirmation of requirements met (by mentor)



#### Note:

Official is provided a mentor to assist with progression through level

Those with experience in Athletics (e.g. athletes, coaches, parents of athletes, P.E. teachers, etc.) can begin at Level 2

## DISCIPLINE SPECIALISTS

### Level 3 Official --- Provincial

#### Role

- Certified to Chief Provincial Championships
- Eligible to Officiate at National Championships



#### Requirements

- Complete Level 3 clinic for discipline
- 1 year of experience as a Level 2 Official
- Successfully complete the Level 3 Assessment
- Complete a practical evaluation by a Provincial Evaluator

#### Note:

Official is provided a mentor to assist with progression through level

### Level 4 Official --- National

#### Role

- Certified to Chief Provincial and National Championships
- Eligible to Officiate at International meets



#### Requirements

- Complete Level 4 clinic for discipline
- 2 years of experience as a Level 3 Official
- Successfully complete the Level 4 Assessment
- Complete two practical evaluations by a National Evaluator

#### Note:

Official is provided a mentor to assist with progression through level

### Level 5 Official --- International

#### Role

- Certified to Chief Provincial, National and International level Championships



#### Requirements

- Complete Level 5 clinic for discipline
- 3 years of experience as a Level 4 Official
- Complete two practical evaluations by a National Evaluator

#### Note:

Official is provided a mentor to assist with progression through level
