



# 2013 TeamBC CANADA SUMMER GAMES TEAM

## BC Team Selection Criteria and Standards

### I. OVERVIEW

- The Canada Summer Games is a Provincial/Territorial Competition for athletes aged 22 and under. The BC Team age range is 16 to 22 years of age as of December 31, 2013. This is a very important competition in the overall BC and Canadian team program. The BC Provincial Government, as do all provincial/territorial governments, financially invests in this program and sees it as an important measure of sport development in the Province. The performance of BC athletes in the Canada Games is a factor in government funding of all sports in BC.
- The 2013 TeamBC Canada Summer Games Team will be selected for competition at the:
  - 2013 Canada Summer Games (Athletics)**  
Sherbrooke, QC (August 11 - 17, 2013)
- BC Athletics and Sport Branch of the Provincial Government will provide support those qualifying athletes.** (see: General Criteria for Funding & Team Selection at <http://www.bcathletics.org/gensel.htm> and the team standards below).
- TEAM SIZE = 50 Athletes + Staff**

### III. SELECTION GUIDELINES

Athletes wishing to be considered for selection to the BC Senior Team must:

1. Meet the BC Athletics General Criteria for Funding Support and Selection
2. Meet the Canada Games eligibility rules which include the ineligibility of athletes who:
  - a. Have SR1 and/or SR2 national cards at any time.
3. Compete in the events they wish to be considered for on the 2013 Canada Games Selection Meet (Jesse Bent Memorial Meet, June 8-9, 2013) **\*\* UPDATE - Those athletes wishing to be considered for combined events will need to compete in a RUN, JUMP and THROW event at the selection meet. Please see details below.**
4. Have been a Registered Competitive Athlete Member of BC Athletics at the time of achieving the Selection Standard
5. Have submitted an Athlete Declaration Form by June 9, 2013
6. Meet the Selection Standards during the window of April 1, 2013 to June 9, 2013
7. Athletes must meet the Selection Criteria, which include the posted standards

#### IV. SELECTION CRITERIA

- **NEW UPDATE: Those athletes wishing to be selected for a Combined Event (Dec/Hep) for the 2013 Canada Summer Games will be required to compete at the trial meet (Jessie Bent Memorial June 8-9) in a run, jump and throws event. Those 3 events will be scored, and the score will be expected to be 30% of the 2013 Decathlon Standard, and 42% of the 2013 Heptathlon standard. Percentages are reflective of 3 events from the total number of events in each combined events discipline (3/10 for Decathlon and 3/7 for Heptathlon).**
- **Selection Criteria:**

Athletes achieving the funding standards will be considered for selection in the following order:

1. Winner in Standard in the selection meet
2. Winner in Non-Standard in the selection meet but having the standard in the current 2013 outdoor season with performances recognized at a sanctioned meet.
3. Non-Winner in Standard in the selection meet. (note, see: Category # 5)
4. Non-Winner in Non-Standard but having achieved the standard in the current 2013 Outdoor season (see: Category # 5)
5. Athletes unable to compete in the selection meet for the reasons listed below will have their performances considered relative to criteria 3, 4 & 6. Notification in writing to BC Athletics is required prior to the start of the first day of competition:
  - a. Illness - a medical certificate is required plus a fitness test and the attainment of a standard prior to selection.
  - b. Injury - as in the above
  - c. Domestic affliction
  - d. Graduation from a Secondary or Post Secondary School
  - e. Conflict with a competition deemed to be of greater importance, notification of which must be made to BC Athletics at least 2 weeks prior to the selection meet (i.e. Canadian or BC Team Competition; Canadian Championship).
6. Other athletes may be considered by nearness to the standard and medal potential based on the results at the trial meets (note, see: Category # 5)

#### V. IMPORTANT INFORMATION - BC ATHLETE ASSISTANCE

##### **\*\* BC ATHLETE ASSISTANCE 2013-2014 \*\*** **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ATHLETES/COACHES**

- Athletes wishing to be considered for BC Athlete Assistance (BC Carding) must take part in the 2013 BC Senior Track & Field Championships unless they are:
  1. **Competing on a Canadian Team or BC Team** - Notification to BC Athletics 2 Weeks prior to the BC Championships
  2. **Injured or Ill** - ONLY a letter from a medical doctor will be accepted. This must be presented prior to the start of the Championships.
  3. **Domestic Affliction** - defined as a personal or family tragedy, incident or emergency that does not allow you to attend the Championships. Notification must be received prior to the start of the Championships unless this is impossible.
  4. **Education, Exam or Graduation Commitment**.
